

IASCOE Directors Meeting  
Thursday April 3, 2014

The meeting of the IASCOE Board of Directors meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Curt Houk. The primary purpose of this meeting was to review bids from interested cities in the 2016 NASCOE Convention. Presentations were given by Iowa City, Des Moines, and Cedar Rapids. Due to the fact that we will be bidding the 2016 National Convention, Iowa will be hosting a hospitality room, along with persons from the Cedar Rapids Visitors' Bureau and the Double Tree Hotel. We are hoping to get at least 20 attendees from Iowa to Oklahoma City.

President Houk introduced Mary Roberts and Bob Braden to the group. Mary is the NAFEC liaison for IASCOE. Bob is a Scott County COC member and also a board member for NAFEC. Both Mary and Bob expressed to the group that they are available to visit with COC members around the state to explain NAFEC's role and the benefits of becoming a NAFEC member.

An introduction of all meeting attendees was held to introduce the new IASCOE board members. Curt Goettsch reviewed the agenda for the IASCOE Convention for the next two days. Several vendors will be set up so he encouraged everyone to visit with them about various benefits available to IASCOE/NASCOE members. Committee chairs were reminded that they will need to take minutes at their respective meetings on Friday and would be expected to present them on Saturday morning during the general assembly.

Being no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 8:30pm.
